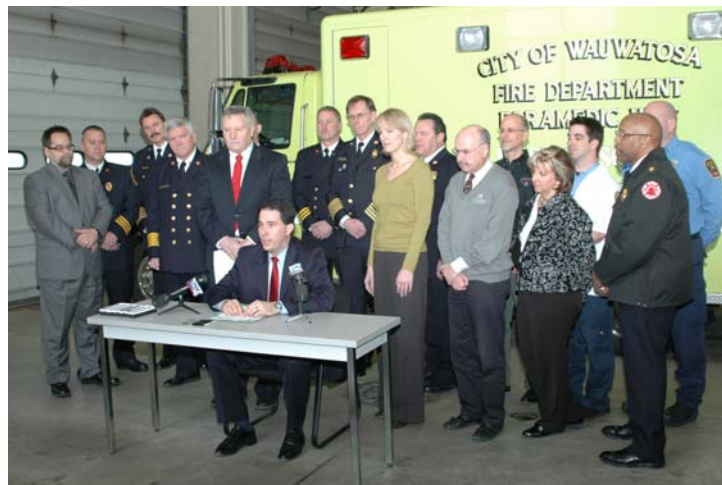

**WALKER SIGNS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES  
CONTRACT RESOLUTION**

MILWAUKEE – County Executive Scott Walker held a news conference this morning at the Wauwatosa Fire Department’s Watertown Plank Road location to sign a resolution to execute a three-year contract for Advanced Life Support (Paramedic) Service and Transport and Paramedic First Response Services with seven municipalities and the North Shore Fire Department. The \$3.5 million in funding is overseen by the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Program - a County partnership with municipal fire departments, the Medical College of Wisconsin, and Froedtert Memorial Lutheran Hospital.

The municipalities participating in the contract are Franklin, Greenfield, Milwaukee, Oak Creek, South Milwaukee, Wauwatosa, and West Allis, along with the North Shore Fire Department.
