An adopted resolution authorizing Milwaukee County to pursue a hydroelectric feasibility study of the Estabrook Dam.

RECOMMENDATION: Adoption of a resolution from the Committee on Parks, Energy and Environment, authorizing and directing the Director of Architectural, Engineering and Environmental Services to ensure that the stability analysis for the Estabrook Dam includes relevant considerations for the possible development of a hydroelectric facility at or near the Estabrook Dam; and the Parks Director is authorized and directed to pursue an expansion of the Lincoln Creek sediment removal project partnership with the U.S. EPA and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, using capital improvement funding included in the 2010 Milwaukee County Adopted Budget for sediment removal near the dam as a local match; and the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors expresses openness to a potential public/private partnership for the development, operation and management of a hydroelectric power generating facility at or near the Estabrook Dam in order to provide renewable energy options for local residents and businesses, and as source of revenue for Milwaukee County to continue its maintenance and operation of the Estabrook Dam. A resolution by Supervisor Larson, establishing a community garden site on a portion of the County-owned former Southshore Railway along South Sixth Street between W. Rosedale Avenue and W. Plainfield Avenue.
